

Congratulations to College of Pharmacy faculty for the following accomplishments:

### **Publication**

Dr. Cynthia Jackevicius, Dr. Lingyun Liu (former fellow of Dr. Jackevicius), and colleagues published an article in the journal *Circulation: Cardiovascular Quality and Outcomes* titled, “Bleeding Risk of Direct Oral Anticoagulants in Patients with Heart Failure and Atrial Fibrillation.”

Summary from the journal: “DOACs overall, apixaban and dabigatran, but not rivaroxaban, were associated with less total bleeding and death than warfarin in patients with heart failure and atrial fibrillation at all levels of renal function. Renal function decline resulted in increased bleeding in patients with DOACs. DOAC dose adjustment was often indicated, associated with increased bleeding when not adjusted, emphasizing the need for closer monitoring in these patients.”

It should also be noted that the authors found more dose adjustments, lower rates of bleeding and death in patients seen by pharmacists, demonstrating the value of pharmacist-provided patient care.
